



RESEARCH TEACHING STAFF (RTS)

We are looking for teachers and researchers with different professional profiles, willing to align themselves with the identity and mission of the ICCI. Candidates must demonstrate a good capacity to integrate into work teams, the necessary skills to carry out teaching activities, and sufficient skills to carry out research work with national and international repercussions.

REQUIREMENTS

- Doctoral degree in economics, education, engineering, etc.
- Teaching and research experience in the university field.
- Publications in international scientific journals with impact factor JCR (Science Edition or Social Sciences Edition) or SCImago Journal Rank (SJR).
- Degree in English, Level C1. Oral and written proficiency in the language for teaching.

In addition, the following aspects will be assessed:

- Obtaining a Ph.D. degree from a foreign university.
- Undergraduate or postgraduate training at a foreign university.
- Positive evaluations of the teaching and/or research activity.
- Participation in research projects, preferably of a competitive nature, financed with European funds.
- Experience in the study of statistical data, in modeling with equations structural and latent variables, in multilevel analysis, etc.
- Membership of international networks linked to the principles and objectives of the ICCI.

FUNCTIONS

- Research in specific areas of knowledge related to accredited training.
- Participate in scientific congresses and university seminars.
- Participate in scientific publications in indexed journals.
- Communicate the results of the research work to the research coordinator, so that he or she can assess the possible dissemination of the results in the media.
- Cooperate with scientific initiatives of other universities.
- Encourage synergies with companies to carry out technology transfer research projects.



RESPONSIBLE FOR EUROPEAN PROGRAMMES

We are looking for people responsible for the writing, coordination, and management of European programmes, with sufficient capacity to carry out various consultancy tasks. Candidates must have a multidisciplinary profile, communication, and organizational skills to manage projects and clients, and demonstrate a high degree of autonomy in their work.

REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's or Bachelor's Degree.
- Accredited knowledge in European Projects and Project Management.
- Minimum work experience of 3 years in European project management and consulting.
- Degree in English, Level C1. Oral and written proficiency in the language.

In addition, the following aspects will be assessed:

- Training at a foreign university.
- Ability to manage people and plan work teams.
- Membership of international networks linked to the principles and objectives of the ICCI.

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Elaboration of proposals for European programmes and projects:
 - Presentation of the proposals, specifying their suitability and the objectives to be met, as well as the planning and follow-up of the different actions to be carried out.
2. Direction and monitoring of approved programmes or projects:
 - Search for partners and creation of consortiums.
 - Coordination of partners and/or consortia.
 - Monitoring of all matters relating to European programme legislation and publicly funded projects.
 - Planning and supervision of activities related to the project.
 - Financial management of the project and regular preparation of monitoring reports economic-financial.
 - Attention to queries and requests for information and documentation related to the execution of the project.
 - Writing diverse administrative documentation; letters of commitment, agreements with partners, etc.
3. Organization and management of all consulting activities.
 - Preparation and publication of calls for proposals to offer consultancy services.
 - Planning of interviews with those who request consulting services, and later the drawing up of the minutes of each one of them.
